IN CITY COUNCIL

WHEREAS:-

It is hereby adjudged necessary for the public convenience and the public health that the present main drain or common sewer in Concord Lane, a private way, should be extended northeasterly a distance of approximately one hundred ~~ten~~ ^{fifty} (110) feet, it is therefore

ORDERED:-

That the said main drain or common sewer be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and the Commissioner of Public Works is hereby authorized and instructed to cause the said main drain or common sewer to be laid out, made and constructed as aforesaid and to report to this City Council after the completion of the work, the cost thereof and assessments shall be made as provided by law upon the abutting estates as follows:-

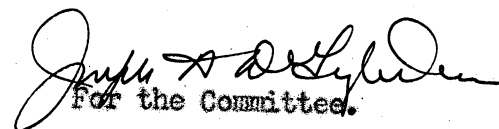
