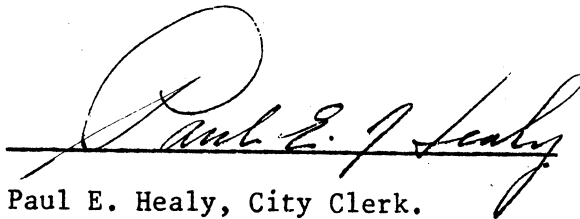

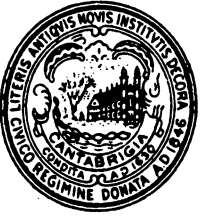

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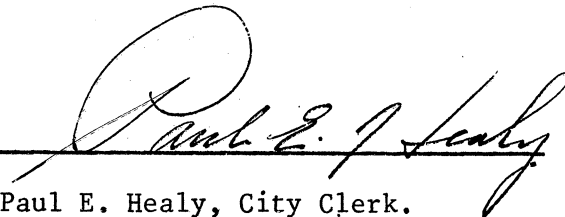

Please be advised that this is a very important issue to us, and one that we feel should be heard, prior to any decision being made as to the future use of this building.

Most of the residents/homeowners on St. Paul St. and the adjoining portion of Prospect St. are native-born Cantabrigians, voters and taxpayers.

Your consideration in this matter would be most appreciated.
