and has forced a hole through the basement

covered with Raw Sewage

2 Percy Place has a constant problem
with their toilet backing up.

3 Percy Place is occupied by an elderly
paraplegic who is bedridden and lives alone.

1 Percy Place has been unoccupied for
over a year now due to the death of my
uncle, Mr. Burgess. the house is now on
for sale.

We need the councilors help . We respectfully request that the right side of our lane, to the utility poles, be kept open to allow emergency vehicles and our oil trucks clear access
