IN BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, }
July 27, 1870. }

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Forest Street, so called, from North Avenue to Oxford Street, should be laid out as a public way, forty feet in width:

It is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That due notice be given to the abutters on said Forest Street, and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to lay out the street before mentioned by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as a public street—and also that due notice be given to all persons and parties owning or having any rights in estates that will be benefitted by the said proposed laying out of said Street, that this Board intends to assess a portion of the expense thereof upon the estates so benefitted according to law—and that

WEDNESDAY,

the 10th day of August next, at 8 1-2 o'clock, P. M.,

is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.
