- WHEREAS: Gerald serves on the AAA National Advisory Council, as well as a Director of the Eastern Conference of AAA Clubs and the Travel Agency Services Management Advisory Committee, along with being active in a number of civic, fraternal and charitable organizations, among them serving as President of the Daniel Webster Council of Boy Scouts of America while working in New Hampshire; now therefore be it

- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Gerald on behalf of the entire City Council.

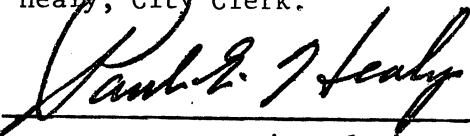
