To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of \$4,536.00 in the General Fund from Property Tax to the Human Services Department Other Ordinary Maintenance Account. The Health Department is developing a plan to administer Hepatitis B vaccinations to first aid providers such as the police and fire departments. The Human Service's Department has 42 childcare staff members that are trained as first aid providers and need to be included in the program. The cost is \$36.00 per shot and 3 shots per person are required. These funds will enable the childcare staff to receive the vaccination.
