This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of Vahan Hintlian, late cofounder of the former Deran Confectionary Company; and

WHEREAS:

Mr. Hintlian, a native of Armenia, emigrated to the United States in 1926, graduate from Somerville High School, Wentworth Institute of Technology and attended Boston University; and

WHEREAS:

Vahan and his family established the candy manufacturing and marketing company in 1929 and owned it until it was acquired by Borden, Inc. in 1970 and while in charge of the company he designed its manufacturing facilities and helped develop and install its processing lines; and

WHEREAS:

Vahan had long been active in both civic and community affairs having served as a trustee of the East Cambridge Savings Bank, the Armenian Assembly of America, as a member of the Board of Directors of the YMCA and the Trinity Men's Union of the Trinity Apostolic Church of Cambridge, to name a few; now therefore be it

RESOLVED:

That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Tarvis Hintlian and to the entire family at this unfortunate personal loss; and be it further

RESOLVED:
