Ordered that the City Manager be requested to immediately and without delay proceed as necessary for the authorization of an expenditure of \$15,000 and the acquisition and installation of a fountain, funds authorized by the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee from a development agreement between the city of Cambridge and the Marcus Organization to pay for the acquisition and ^{said} installation.

The fountain as described by the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee, was to be made in Coimbra Portugal, shipped at the city of Coimbra expense and installed with part of the \$15,000 funding.

On May 7, 1985, the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee voted unanimously to support the installation of the public fountain at St. Anthony Church, at 34, Umberto Cardinal Medeiros Avenue.

The grounds at Saint Anthony Church were designed to include a fountain to be highly visible from Cambridge street.

Further Ordered

That this City Council endorse and vote for the fountain that was authorized by the East Cambridge Stabilization Committee and urges the City Council to proceed with "full speed ahead" and with the blessing of the City Council and City Managers.
