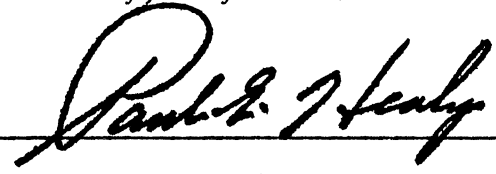
IN CITY COUNCIL

- ORDERED: That the city manager report in two weeks on his progress on this matter.
