Sister Agnes Donnelly of Ipswich, was 95

Sister Agnes St. John Donnelly, S.N.D. of Ipswich died Saturday at Massachusetts General Hospital after a brief illness. She was 95.

Born in Cambridge, she had been residing at the Sisters of Notre Dame Convent, Ipswich, since her retirement.

Sister Donnelly attended Emmanuel College and received her bachelor of science degree in accounting, law secretarial science and business management.

She entered the Sister of Notre Dame de Namur at Waltham in 1920, professed her first vow in 1923 and made her final vows in 1926.

Sister Donnelly's teaching ministries were at Holy Redeemer, East Boston; Okayama, Japan; St. Gregory, Dorchester; St. Mary, Lawrence; Academy of Notre Dame, Tyngsboro; St. Mary, Cambridge; St. Charles, Woburn; and Our Lady of the Presentation, Brighton.

She is survived by a sister, Marie M. of Arlington.

A funeral Mass will be celebrated tomorrow at 11 a.m. at Our Lady Queen Chapel, Ipswich.

Burial will be in Notre Dame Cemetery, Ipswich.

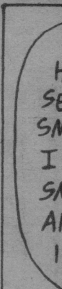

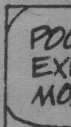
