
Dear Mr. Sullivan:

I respectfully submit the following for your consideration.

On January 10, 1974, the Auditing Department notified Dr. Philip Porter, Chief of Pediatrics, that there were insufficient funds in the Out-Patient Extension Clinic grant. A deposit to this account dated September 27, 1972 for \$7,494 was inadvertently credited to General Revenue. Since the error occurred in 1972, the money cannot now be transferred back to the Out-Patient Department Extension grant, and the account shows this deficit. The City Auditor has refused to honor any further charges against the account until this matter is resolved. The grant is from the Department of Public Health, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and supports part-time health assistants and secretarial help in the Pediatric Neighborhood Health Centers.

I request that you submit to the City Council, a special appropriation of \$7,494, to restore the money to this account.


