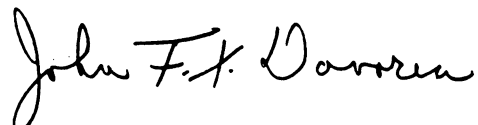

I) Promotes the understanding of Islam among Muslims and non-Muslims.

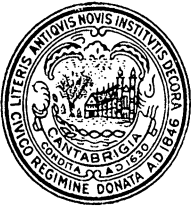
II) Persuades Muslims to make their commitment to Islam more meaningful.

Pursuant to a communication from the Secretary of State re: "Harvard Islamic Society, Inc.," I made an investigation. The locus is suitable.

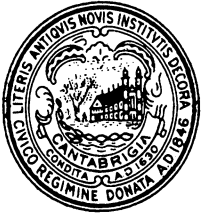

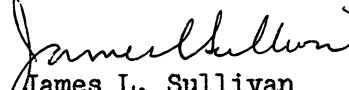
