Dear Sirs:

This letter is a request that Urban Outfitters be granted a permit to conduct sidewalk sales in the sidewalk area fronting our store at 11 J. F. Kennedy St. in Cambridge.

As our doorway is recesses four feet from the sidewalk and the sidewalk is nine feet wide, this permit would not impede the flow of foot traffic as we would not need more than four feet additional. We would want to be allowed to use this space only on Saturdays and Sundays during the spring summer and fall seasons. We would use this space only between the hours of 10-6 on Saturdays and 12-6 on Sundays. Urban Outfitters would staff the area well and be fully responsible for clean-up.

I hope that you would give this request your consideration at your earliest convenience, and hope to be hearing from you soon.

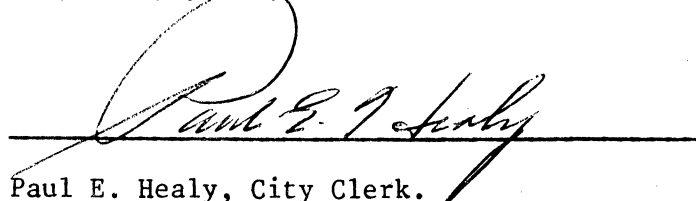
