Vincent R. Powers, 71

Worked at DeScenzo Diamonds

Vincent R. Powers, a lifelong Medford resident and longtime employee of DeScenzo Diamonds in Boston, died Friday at his son's home in Winchester. He was 71.

Mr. Powers graduated from Medford High School. After serving in the US Navy during World War II, he attended Boston College and graduated in 1952.

Mr. Powers spent his summers in Scituate and was an active member of the community there as well as in Medford.

He was a member of the Hatherly Country Club in Scituate and of the Cambridge YMCA.

He leaves five sons, Stephen J. of Medford, Richard V. of Barrington, R.I., John E. of Brookline, Mark G. of Andover, and Gerard F. of Winchester; and a brother, Richard of Centerville.

Funeral services will be held tomorrow at 11 a.m. at the Sacred Heart Church in Medford. Burial will follow at the Oak Grove Cemetery in Medford.
