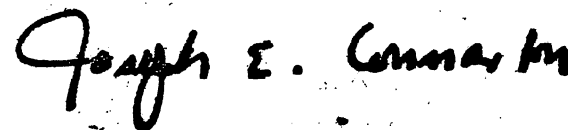

To the Honorable, the City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the transfer of \$100,000.00 from the Employee Benefits Salaries and Wages account to the Employee benefits Other Ordinary Maintenance account to provide funds needed to cover rising costs in the City's share of Medicare insurance. Under provisions of a federal law passed in 1986, all new employees are required to pay 1.45% of their gross pay for Medicare insurance. In addition, the City is required to match the 1.45% employee contribution.

Passage of this order is recommended.
