At a meeting of the Emergency Finance Board of the Commonwealth, held on the 31st day of July, 1974, a majority of said Board being present, the following vote was passed:

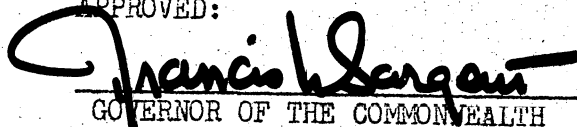
VOTED: To approve the application of the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE for the Neighborhood Facilities Project for Area Four, Columbia and Hampshire Streets, being Project No. NFP-MA-01-06-1004, at a presently estimated cost of THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY THREE THOUSAND, EIGHT HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$373,800.00); and to approve the application of the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE for a Grant from the United States of America, Department of Housing and Urban Development Neighborhood Facilities Grant Program, in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FORTY NINE THOUSAND, TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$249,200.00).

Authorization for said project is in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 74 of the Acts of 1945, as amended.

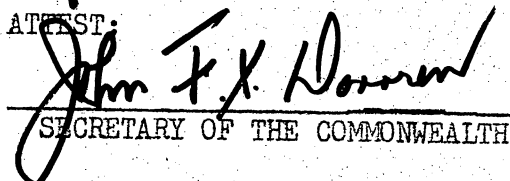

At a meeting of the Emergency Finance Board of the Commonwealth, held on the 31st day of July, 1974, a majority of said Board being present, the following vote was passed:

VOTED: To approve the application of the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE for the Neighborhood Facilities Project for 105 Windsor Street and 97 Cherry Street, being Project No. NFP-MA-01-06-1006, at a presently estimated cost of THREE HUNDRED FIFTY SEVEN THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED FIFTY FIVE DOLLARS and FIFTY CENTS (\$357,655.50); and to approve the application of the CITY OF CAMBRIDGE for a Grant from the United States of America, Department of Housing and Urban Development Neighborhood Facilities Grant Program, in the amount of TWO HUNDRED THIRTY EIGHT THOUSAND, FOUR HUNDRED THIRTY SEVEN DOLLARS (\$238,437.00).
