Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be directed to set edgestones upon the sidewalks in the streets hereinafter named. The expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department, (Paving: Edgestones and Sidewalks.) The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the owners of abutting estates, under the provisions of Chapter 191, of the Legislative Acts of the year 1863.

and south-east corners of ^{Pearl} ~~Brookline~~ and Henry Streets
