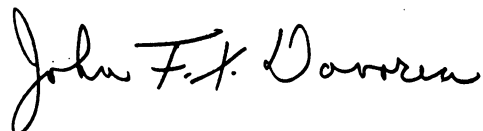

2. The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

The corporation's purposes are to provide educational and counselling services for men and women who have been or are imprisoned in prisons and jails; to provide such services to the families and friends of said persons; to provide educational and informational services to the public at large concerning the problems of prisons and of the communities from which prisoners come; to raise and distribute funds for the aforesaid purposes; and to carry on any educational or charitable function permitted by the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts to a non-profit corporation organized under Chapter 180 of the General Laws. The aforementioned powers are in furtherance of but not in limitation of the general powers conferred by Chapter 180, as amended, and as further limited by the exempt purposes set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the U. S. Internal Revenue Code, as amended.
