Gentlemen:

The Metropolitan Transit Authority respectfully petitions for permission to establish and to move trackless trolley stops and erect stanchions with signs reading "Trackless Trolley Stop - No Parking" at the following locations on Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge:

Inbound on the Southerly side of Massachusetts Avenue


Easterly side of Arrow Street, starting at #1130 Mass. Ave. and extending 65 feet Easterly.

At the Easterly side of Lansdowne Street, move the Westerly stanchion to a point 65 feet Easterly of the present Easterly stanchion.

Outbound on the Northerly side of Massachusetts Avenue

Westerly side of Hancock Street, to be moved to the Easterly side and to extend 65 feet Easterly.

Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 28, Regulation of Traffic - Article III, Section 4, Location of Bus Stops, trackless trolley stops, taxicab stands and service zones. The Metropolitan Transit Authority is hereby given permission to establish and to move trackless trolley stops and erect stanchions with signs reading "Trackless Trolley Stop - No Parking" at the following locations on Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge:-

Inbound on the southerly side of Massachusetts Avenue

Easterly side of Arrow Street, starting at No. 1130 Massachusetts Avenue and extending 65 feet easterly.

At the easterly side of Lansdowne Street, move the westerly stanchion to a point 65 feet easterly of the present easterly stanchion.

Outbound on the northerly side of Massachusetts Avenue

Westerly side of Hancock Street, to be moved to the easterly side and to extend 65 feet easterly.
