Be it resolved that the mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association hereby gives its approval of the appointment of Mr. Spence to the Task Force; and

Be it resolved that the mid-Cambridge Neighborhood Association requests that additional residents of Mid-Cambridge be appointed to the Task Force.

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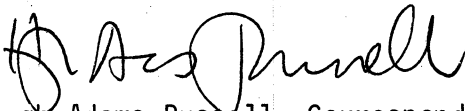
