- WHEREAS: Firefighter Lawson on January 3, 1971 was transferred to Engine Nine where he remained until his retirement on April 29, 1981; and
- WHEREAS: Firefighter Lawson will be missed by his colleagues and friends who have grown to know him over the nearly twenty-four years of service which he provided the City of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its sincere appreciation and gratitude to Firefighter William A. Lawson upon his retirement and to further extend its wishes for a healthy and happy retirement; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare for presentation a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Firefighter Lawson on behalf of the entire City Council.
