on the corner of Washington Street, and the
proposed extension of Portland Street, on the

rate at which land is now being sold, in
that section, and further that by taking so
much land as has been required, and
decreasing the size of the lot, it is left too small
for any other purpose than the foundation of
a small dwelling, and cannot therefore reap any
benefit from the proposed improvement
