 The condition of those courts.
 The extent of demand and use in each location.

Which courts are available to the High School teams.
 Which courts are suitable for inter-scholastic matches.

Especially as to the Glacken Playground courts:-

Whether they are suitable for inter-scholastic matches and, if not, what can be done and the estimated cost to put them in suitable condition so that they can be properly maintained after winter use for skating.
