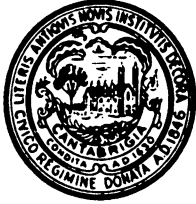

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$79,200.00 in the Grant Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account (\$42,031.97), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$36,768.03) and the Travel and Training Account (\$400.00) from the Massachusetts Executive Office of Communities and Development. These funds will be used for the Homeless Intercept Program for the second half of FY96. This increase is the result of a contract amendment increasing our maximum obligation to \$151,200.00. These funds are used to prevent homelessness by providing counseling for tenants, counseling for landlords, mediation for disputes between tenants and landlords and housing search assistance for families facing eviction.
