revised by Secs. 3.301 & 3.303 new code.

Differences: new code updates old & is more reflective of the City's operations.

Secs. 2-59 thru Sec. 2-68, re: Auditing Dept.

revised by Sec. 3.306  $\Rightarrow$  Sec. 3.308

Diff.: Powers & duties incorp by ref to G.L.C. 41 § 49-54A. Old code specifies duties.  
new code generalizes duties

Sec. 2-78  $\Rightarrow$  Sec. 2-77 re: Duties of Purchasing Agent pp. 47-52  
revised by Sec. 3.317 (a-g)

Diff.: new code generalizes duties  $\Rightarrow$  Old Code specifies

Sec. 2-100 Duty of Treas. as Collector of Taxes

revised by Sec. 3.327, giving this duty to Asst. City Treasurer.

Sec. 2-100 through Sec. 2-117 re: Treasury

revised by Sec. 3.324 through 3.329 - duties made more precise by NEW CODE

NEW CODE also provides for Asst. Treas. apptd by Treas. with duties of  
Revenue Collector, & bond requirement.

Sec 2-191 ⇒ 2-196 re: salaries, OT, etc. ⇒ replaced by Sec. 3.909 - Adoption of Salary and Classification Plan by reference.

Sec. 5-1 - Adop. Bldg Code by Ref. ⇒ Sec. 7.101 - 7.103; provisions of Ord. 854

Sec. 7.401; 7.402 NEW CODE - estab. of Fire District - not in old code - No new Ord. quoted.

Sec. 15-8 re: Absence of Police Chief (Ord. No. 432, 1953) - struck & not replaced. Old code has Chief as head of dept., new Code has Commissioner as head

Sec. 10.111 re: Preservation of Apparatus (FIRE) - new; not in old code; no new ord. quoted

Sec. 19-6 re: Water Board, personal interest in it prohibited
