That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to direct the License Commission and the Police Department to issue the necessary permits and approvals to Rachel Kabasakalian of the Racial Justice Task Force of the American Friends Service Committee for the conduct of a demonstration and vigil to be held from 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Saturday, October 16, 1982 in front of the Central Square Post Office in Cambridge for the purpose of demonstrating against racial violence in the the City, provided that the free flow of foot traffic will not be interrupted by the demonstration and in accordance with all the General Ordinances of the City of Cambridge and the laws of the Commonwealth.
