

An Ordinance  
in relation to the payment of certain  
Laborers to be employed by the  
Water Board in connecting and  
improving certain Ponds, under special  
authority from the City Council.

Be it Ordained by the City Council  
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:

Sect. 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized  
to draw his drafts, from time to time  
upon the City Treasurer, for the  
payment of Laborers employed in  
connecting and improving certain  
Ponds, under special authority  
from the City Council, for the sum  
of one Thousand Dollars each; such  
drafts to be countersigned by the  
Auditor, and the amount thereof  
to be charged to the Appropriation  
for Extension of Water Works.

Sect. 2. Such draft shall be placed in  
the hands of the City Treasurer, who  
shall pay to the laborers above mentioned  
such sums as shall be called for by  
orders given to them in the manner

Hereinafter provided, upon presentation and delivery to him of such orders; Provided, however, that the aggregate amount so paid by the Treasurer, shall not exceed the amount of the Mayor's drafts which he shall have received.

Sec. 3. The Water Board is hereby authorized to prepare suitable orders upon the Treasurer for the payment of One Dollar, each, - one of which orders may be paid by said Board, or its authorized agent, under such regulations as the Board may prescribe, to a laborer for each day's work at the Ponds; and such orders when paid, shall be delivered up to the City Treasurer and retained by him.

Sec. 4. Whenever it shall appear from the books of the Treasurer that the amount of the Mayor's drafts is exhausted, or nearly so, the Mayor is hereby authorized to draw further drafts, and so from time to time, as may be required to meet the orders of the Water Board; Provided, however,

That the aggregate amount of the  
Mayor's drafts shall not exceed the  
amount specially appropriated  
for the work above mentioned.
