- RESOLVED: That this City Council do hereby proclaim the week of April 22 through 28, 1985, as

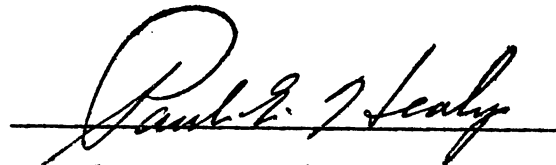
### "VOLUNTEER TAX ASSISTANCE WEEK"
