That this City Council extends its heartfelt warm congratulations to Frank Cardullo on this special occasion as being selected "Man of the Year"; and be it further

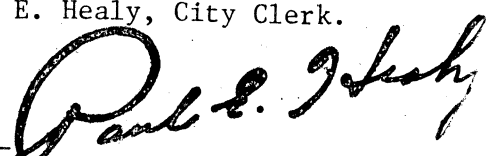
