Subject City Council Order #21 of November 19, 1984 "Traffic Light
At Garden and Mason Street"

Our investigation of this intersection revealed that many vehicles were in fact turning right on the red light while pedestrians were crossing Mason Street and Garden Street. We do have a sign stating that all vehicles must "Turn Right On Right Arrow Only" and although it is visible to the drivers, we believe that most drivers ignored it. We have therefore installed another sign on the traffic signal which in our opinion is very predominant to the driver as he is looking at the signal.

I have informed the police department of this and they will be watching this intersection.
