- WHEREAS: The number of noise and public nuisance complaints are rapidly increasing throughout the city and current city staff are unable to meet the demand; and
- WHEREAS: The City Council currently has under active consideration an amendment to the Municipal Code relative to Street Performers; and
- WHEREAS: It would make the implementation of the proposed ordinance more equitable and consistent to have a specifically trained individual to take meter readings and sound measurements; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to consider the feasibility of hiring an individual who is a sound technician or its equivalent in order to address the multitude of noise complaints currently being received and who would be available to monitor noise levels during the peak entertainment season within the City.
