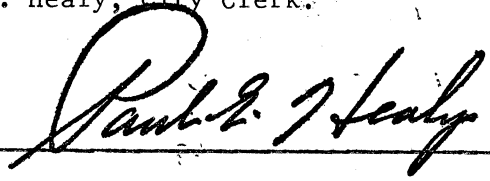

- WHEREAS: John was a graduate of the University of Missouri and in 1932 received his law degree from Harvard Law School and later held positions of varying responsibility at United Carr, Inc. and TRW, Inc., serving as Assistant Secretary, having already held such positions as Vice-President and General Counsel at Carr, Inc.; and
- WHEREAS: John was a long time active member of Christ Church, Episcopal, in Harvard Square, serving as Junior and Senior Warden, as Member of the Vestry and as Co-Chairman of the Centennial Committee for the Church; and
- WHEREAS: John also served his community as a Director of the Cambridge Trust Bank, past Chairman of the Cambridge Red Cross and as a Member of the Executive Board of the Cambridge Council, Boy Scouts of America; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Isabelle Dry and to the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Dry on behalf of the entire City Council.
