It is to be noted that seven (7) former presidents of Harvard College are buried in the burial grounds namely, Henry Dunster (1640-1649); Charles Chauncy, (1654-72); Uriah Oakes, (1608-1681); John Leverett, (1708-24); Benjamin Wadsworth, (1725-37); and Joseph Williard, (1781-1804) and Edward Holyoke, (1737-69).

Also located at the burial site are the graves of numerous fellows, tutors, stewards, ministers, and faculty associated with the colleges, which it is assured that at least one Stabian is included.

It is hoped that the Historical Commission will continue the work of keeping up "improvement work" at the Old Burial Grounds site.
