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Shelter, Inc. is a private non-profit human service organization providing lodging, food, social services, child development services, advocacy and referrals to nearly 1,000 homeless men, women and children each year.

We believe homeless people are entitled to respectful treatment in dignified facilities. Towards that end, we have developed community-based homelike programs with quality social services.

Currently Shelter, Inc. operates two programs for the homeless in the Greater Boston area. Our Cambridge Shelter offers emergency overnight shelter to twenty homeless men and women and to two families. The Boston Family Shelter is a transitional facility for 8 — 10 families providing longer term shelter and extended services to our guests. Successful relocation to permanent housing is an integral part of Shelter, Inc.'s programs.

Supported through a public/private/voluntary partnership, Shelter, Inc. has, since 1974, been providing the highest quality services to our guests. Today, Shelter, Inc. continues to be a dynamic growing organization meeting the diverse needs of the homeless population. Plans for the near future include long term transitional/educational programs for families as well as similar plans for transitional programs for homeless individuals.

Shelter, Inc. has progressed tremendously since its grassroots beginnings thanks to the generosity of the community. Today, as we move forward, we depend on your continued support to help some of the neediest and most vulnerable people in our communities and to develop new approaches toward breaking the cycle of homelessness.
