In the year one thousand eight hundred and seventy

Be it Ordained by the City Council of the City
of Cambridge, as follows: -

- Section 1. The committee on Public Property shall, during the month of January of each year, make a careful estimate of the amount required for the purchase of public lands and erection of public buildings and shall on or before the tenth day of February submit such estimate with items to the chairman of the committee on Finance.
- Section 2. The Committee on Finance shall place in the annual appropriation bill an item denominated "The Public Land and Building Fund" which said item shall be the total of all sums that in the opinion of said committee on Finance may be required for the purchase of public Land or the erection of public Buildings.
- Section 3. The above named fund or any part thereof shall never be assigned for any special purpose until the Committee on Public Property shall have consummated the negotiation for the purchase of the required land or the erection of the proposed building, when if the terms of contract are satisfactory to the City Council the necessary amount shall be appropriated.
- Section 4. No additional appropriation shall be made for the construction of ^{any} public Building except in case where the original contractor shall have forfeited his Bond by reason of failure to comply with his obligations.
