

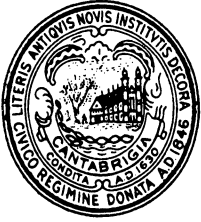
We would like an opportunity to present our feelings on this matter at the City Council meeting called for Monday, November 16, 1970, prior to any action on the appointments .


I submit, subject to your consideration, the following persons for these two positions -
