- WHEREAS: A career law enforcement employee recently retired from active duty, completing nearly thirty-eight years of public service; and
- WHEREAS: That individual, Detective William (Billy) Maher, devoted his entire adult life to working in and improving the criminal justice system not only within the City of Cambridge and the County of Middlesex, but throughout the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, beginning his long career in 1947 as a Boston Police Officer, having been honorably discharged in 1945 from the United States Navy; and
- WHEREAS: Billy, as he is known by his legion of friends, entered the Cambridge Police Department in 1956, and with one or two notable exceptions worked for twenty-one years in various patrol and investigative positions, always being available to assist a fellow human being, regardless of race, creed color or natural origin; and
- WHEREAS: One notable exception to his law enforcement career was the time period of January, 1966 to January, 1968, when Billy served as a member of the Cambridge City Council, a position from which he continued providing service and advice to the people of Cambridge; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deep appreciation to Detective William (Billy) Maher for his commitment to the people of Cambridge and the law enforcement community and to further extend to him every good wish for much health and happiness; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to prepare a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution for presentation to Detective William (Billy) Maher on behalf of the entire City Council.
