1. The curriculum for training of elderly security staff is complete and arrangements are being made with the police department for that portion of the curriculum. We are prepared to provide training as soon as finalists have been selected for the positions.

2. All applicants for the positions available have been interviewed by a Committee comprised of CHA staff and representatives of the appropriate tenant councils. Unfortunately, only seven applications were received for the eight weekend positions, and they do not appear to be sufficiently qualified candidates to fill all of the weekday positions. While some appropriate finalists have been identified, we are proceeding with the CETA office to undertake an ambitious outreach effort to recruit more applicants for the existing positions.
