- WHEREAS: Hermes was a United States Navy veteran; and
- WHEREAS: Hermes was a world-renowned Massachusetts General hospital thoracic surgeon whose groundbreaking procedures saved countless lives and brought him recognition as "the father of modern-day tracheal surgery"; and
- WHEREAS: Hermes has published more than 350 scientific articles; and
- WHEREAS: Hermes's passing will leave a void in the lives of all his surviving family, his wife Charlotte (Robinson) Grillo; his children Andrea Massar, Paula Shalan, and Amy and H. Conrad Grillo Jr.; his nine grandchildren; and his former wife Dorothy (Whittier) Grillo; and
- WHEREAS: Hermes will be sorely missed by all he touched and loved; now therefore be it
