- WHEREAS: The Gore Street neighborhood can boast of a high concentration of both active and passive recreational facilities; and
- WHEREAS: The Gold Star Mothers Park, the Gore Street Skating Rink and the Luke Agnetta Basketball Court attracts area residents from toddlers to elders; and
- WHEREAS: Given this high concentration in an urban setting, questions arise concerning the adequate safety of those who enjoy these facilities; now therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to confer with appropriate departmental personnel with a view in mind of conducting a comprehensive traffic study; examination of present lighting; crosshatching crosswalks; and the possible installation of speed bumps.
