- WHEREAS: All current residents of Washington Elms who desire to remain in their present apartments during construction and renovation should be permitted to remain; and
- WHEREAS: The proposed comprehensive modernization will proceed in various phases, thereby allowing other apartments within Washington Elms to become available over a specified period of time; therefore be it
- ORDERED: That the Cambridge Housing Authority be and hereby is requested to give absolute priority for housing within the "new Washington Elms" to all those residents who remain at the Elms during re-construction as well as to those residents who accept temporary relocation outside of the development.
