To The Honorable, The City Council:

Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant for \$1,137,000.00 from the Department of Housing and Urban Development Extraordinary Expenditures account to provide funding under the National Affordable Housing Act of 1990 for the rehabilitation and construction of affordable housing units. The selection of projects will be based on the City's Comprehensive Housing Affordability strategy which was recently approved by HUD. The affordable housing units to be developed include acquisition/moderate rehabilitation, substantial rehabilitation, and new construction for low income families and individuals who require social service support. Emphasis will be placed on rental units, particularly for low income families, although home ownership possibilities will also be considered.
