In Common Council, Nov 27th 1861.

Ordered,

That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized and instructed to fill up the creek under Broadway, near the Oil Factory, making a proper culvert therein as required by the Statute authorizing such filling up. Also to raise the side walk on Hampshire Street and that on the North side of Broadway so as to make the top of the same above the reach of the highest tides - and that the expense thereof be charged to the appropriation for the repairs of Streets and Side-walks.

Amended by inserting after the word tides in the 8th line, "Also to raise the side walk on the North side of Hampshire Street between Bedford and Columbia streets, provided the abutments will bear one half the expense of the same; and inserting ^{the word} "remaining" between the word "the" and the word "expense" in the 9th line.
