In Board of Aldermen, July 7 1869.

The Committee on Roads & Bridges to whom was referred the petition of Cha^s H Allen et al, have considered the same. They find that Temple St was laid out in 1805, and has been kept in repair by the abutters since that time. Although it is not of the width required by the City Ordinance, yet in consideration of its having been laid out and built upon before the Ordinance was passed, and moreover as it is not a through street, requiring a great width of road way for the accommodation of public travel, the committee would therefore recommend that Temple St be accepted by the line indicated by the buildings and fences on said street, when the abutters shall furnish a plan and profile of the same, to be approved by the City Engineer, and when they shall grade the street to the satisfaction of the Superintendent of Streets.
