

City of Cambridge,

In the year One Thousand Eight Hundred & Seventy six.

An Ordinance in relation to payment of City Employees.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Cambridge as follows,

Sect. 1. Heads of departments shall furnish monthly payrolls of employees in their respective departments, stating the name of each employee, the time for which payment is to be made, the rate of wages and the amount due him.

Sect. 2. The City Treasurer shall in person or by his clerk pay each employee of the city, - shall take therefor the receipt of no other person than such employee, - and may, whenever it is reasonably necessary to save loss of time to the employees, send a clerk with the necessary funds to such localities as may be convenient for paying the men.
