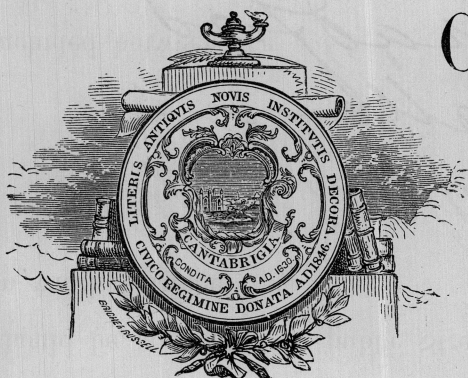




CITY OF CAMBRIDGE.

IN BOARD OF ALDERMEN,

July 16, 1873.

WHEREAS: It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that

*Cottage Street
between Magazine and Pearl Streets*

should be laid out as a public Street. Ordered that a strip of land *forty feet*
in width between

Magazine Street and Pearl Street

included between the *red* lines as shown on a plan drawn by *W. S. Barbour*
and A. Hodges dated *march 21, 1873*

and now before this Board, be taken for public use and laid out as a public Street.

Ordered that *no* damages be allowed for the land so taken as aforesaid. *and*
that thirty days be allowed for the removal
of fences & other obstructions standing on the
land so taken as aforesaid.

Adopted. Sever closed for convenience.
