

An Ordinance
in Relation to the Salary and Duties
of the City Treasurer and Collector
of Taxes.

Be it ordained by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge, as follows:—

Sect. 1. The collector of Taxes shall
hereafter receive the sum of eight
hundred dollars for collecting the
taxes aforesaid per the year in which
he shall be chosen collector; [and all
fees for summonses, warrants, and other
services shall be paid into the
City Treasury.]

Sect. 2. From and after the first
Monday in January, in the year 1861,
the salary of the City Treasurer shall
be five hundred dollars annually, pay-
able in equal quarterly payments;
which shall be in full for all ser-

rices rendered by him in his official capacity.

Sect. 3. The office of the Treasurer shall be kept open, for the transaction of official business, every day, between the hours of nine o'clock, A. M., and one o'clock, P. M., Sundays and holidays excepted.

Sect. 4. The eleventh section of the Ordinances in relation to the collection of Taxes, on the one hundred and eightieth page of the volume of City Ordinances, and so much of the Ordinance establishing the salaries of City Officers, on the one hundred and twenty-seventh page of the same volume, as is inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.
