- WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of this City Council that long time Cambridge resident Harold Thompson, Acting Regional Administrator of Region I for the Department of Housing and Urban Development, is currently under consideration as Regional Administrator of Region I; and
- WHEREAS: Harold Thompson was a community activist in Cambridge, serving as a member of the Cambridge Housing Authority from 1964 to 1970 and has completed seventeen years of service as the Regional Administrator in Region I and is the senior career official within the Region; and
- WHEREAS: During Harold's tenure at the Cambridge Housing Authority, he exercised leadership in the area of housing advocacy for low and moderate income families and worked tirelessly with disadvantaged groups throughout the community to improve their overall quality of life; and
- WHEREAS: Throughout Harold's Federal career he has consistently shown leadership, comprehensive ability and dedication, serving as the Number Two Executive for the entire Region I; therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record urging the Secretary of Housing and Urban Development to recognize the ability and performance of Harold Thompson, not only during his long career as the Deputy Administrator but in his new capacity as the Acting Regional Administrator for the entire Region; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is instructed to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to the Honorable Samuel Pierce, Secretary of the Department of Housing and Urban Development of the United States of America.
