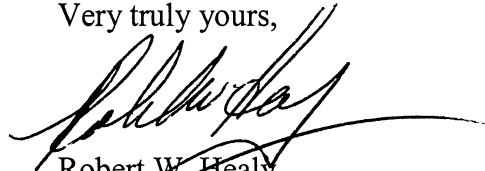

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$45,690 in the Grant Fund of the Public Works Department Salary and Wages Account (\$31,000) and Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$14,690). The Commonwealth of Massachusetts has awarded funds through its Municipal Recycling Incentive Program (MRIP), which provides funds to municipalities to support environmental programs.
