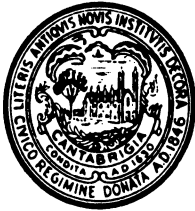

RE: Western Avenue Survey

In accordance with City Council Order No. 17 of November 18 the Community Development Department in conjunction with the Mayor's Office has completed a survey of residents on Western Avenue concerning the proposed name change of Western Avenue to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. All residents that reside on Western Avenue were sent a copy of the letter describing the name change with a return self addressed postage paid postcard. A total of 277 cards were sent to 127 structures, a total of 277 dwelling units. Nineteen envelopes were returned undeliverable. The results of the survey are below:
